

1. eloquent : (adj): able to express your ideas & opinions well, especially in a way that influences people; vividly expressive (like a painting); expressive & persuasive
 Syn: fluent, forceful, persuasive
 Noun: eloquence Adv: eloquently

2. grinace :
 (verb): to make an unpleasant face to indicate displeasure or pain; to twist your face in an ugly way because you do not like something or because you are feeling pain.
 (noun): a twisted face; unpleasant facial expression

3. don : (verb): to put on a piece of clothing

4. steely (adj):
 a. Extremely determined & very strong
 b. Severe or stern (like a glare)

5. avarice (noun): a greedy desire to have a lot of money; greed
 adj: avaricious

6. incongruous : (adj): strange, unexpected, or unsuitable in a particular situation; something that doesn't fit into its surroundings
 Syn: incompatible; inappropriate

7. opportunist : (noun): someone who takes advantage of any opportunity to advance his own situation

8. succinct : (adj): clearly expressed in a few words; clearly & briefly stated
 Syn: terse, brevity, concise
 Adv: succinctly

9. pompous : (adj): someone who thinks they are important & shows this by using long words & being very formal; someone who has too much self-esteem; pretentious.

10. gingerly (adverb): something done carefully & cautiously or slowly & carefully because you are afraid it will be dangerous or painful
