A	Bias				(noun) an opinion about whether a person, group, or idea is good or bad that influences how you deal with it; a tendency to mentally lean in a certain direction (verb): to unfairly influence attitudes, choices, or decisions; to cause to have a bias; influence; prejudice					
B	Refute				(verb): a) to prove that a statement or idea is not correct; to prove untrue b) To say that a statement is wrong or unfair; to say something is untrue c)					
C	Claim				(noun): a) a demand for something which is due b) a statement made as a fact (verb): a) to assert ownership of something b) to state that something is true, even though it has not been proved					
D	Adoration				(noun): a feeling of great love or worship; love, devotion, and respect					
E	Critique				(noun): a piece of written criticism of a set of ideas, a work of art, etc.; a detailed explanation of the problems of something such as a set of political ideas or a book; a review of something; evaluation (verb): a) a critical analysis or evaluation of a subject, situation, literary work, etc. b) the act or art of criticizing					

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F	Advocate	<p>(verb) to publically support a particular way of doing something; to speak, write, or stand up for something or someone</p> <p>(noun): a person who pleads another's cause (such as a lawyer); someone who publically supports someone or something; someone who speaks or writes in favor of something</p>
G	Synthesis	<p>(noun): a) a combining a number of different parts or ideas to come up with a new theory or idea; something that has been made by combining different or separate things to make a whole b) the formation of something complex or more complete by combining similar things</p>
H	Assess	<p>(verb):</p> <p>a) To make a judgment about a person or situation after thinking carefully about it; to evaluate or analyze; judge</p> <p>b) To calculate the value or cost of something</p>
I	implore	<p>(verb): to ask for something in an emotional way; to beg or plead; to make a very serious or emotional request; beg; entreat</p>
J	Reaffirm	<p>(verb): to formally state an opinion, belief, or intention again, especially when someone has questioned you or expressed a doubt; to formally state something again to emphasize that it is true; to affirm or assert again; reiterate</p>
